The Family, Career and Community Leaders of America (FCCLA) National Board of Directors recently held their spring meeting. The Committees of the Board presented reports and discussion was held on new and pending matters.

At this meeting, the Board approved to support a category restructure of Competitive Events beginning in the 2019-2020 academic year as illustrated below:

New STAR Event Category Structure

Level 1 – through grade 8

Level 2 – grades 9-10

Level 3 – grades 11-12

Note: Mixed level teams are still allowed to compete but must compete at the highest level of the teams' members.

The Board is analyzing the data collected from the Membership Affiliation Type survey sent out to constituents. The discussion on streamlining membership by updating the FCCLA membership categories from occupational and comprehensive into one category will continue at the summer meeting.

The 2019 – 2020 proposed budget was reviewed by the Board.

The Board of Directors will continue the leadership work of the organization at their summer meeting in conjunction with the National Leadership Conference.
