### Integration of Core Academics Award 2017-2018 National Award Guidelines

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Family, Career and Community Leaders of America (FCCLA) recognizes a current chapter adviser of FCCLA who integrates one or more core academic subjects (language arts, mathematics, social studies, science) into Family and Consumer Sciences education and/or FCCLA projects and activities.

The mission of FCCLA is to promote personal growth and leadership development through family and consumer sciences education. Focusing on the multiple roles of family member, wage earner, and community leader, members develop skills for life through: character development, creative and critical thinking, interpersonal communication, practical knowledge, and career preparation.

The purpose of FCCLA is

- to provide opportunities for personal development and preparation for adult life
  - to strengthen the function of the family as the basic unit of society
  - to encourage democracy through cooperative action in the home and community
  - to encourage individual and group involvement in helping achieve global cooperation and harmony
  - to promote greater understanding between youth and adults
  - to provide opportunities for making decisions and for assuming responsibilities
  - to prepare for the multiple roles of men and women in today's society
  - to promote Family and Consumer Sciences, careers and related occupations
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#### **DEADLINE:**

**All nominations are due to FCCLA National Headquarters postmarked by April 1, 2018. Nominations sent after the April 1, 2018 postmark deadline will not be considered.**

#### **Criteria**

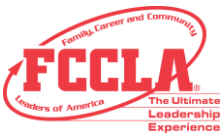
Nominees will be recognized for their service to Family, Career and Community Leaders of America, Inc., in one or more of the areas listed below. An evaluation committee comprised of a chapter adviser, school administrator/professional, and business and industry representative makes selection. Evaluation will be based on the following:

- Additional information will not be considered in the award selection, except for letters of recommendation, lesson plans, and handouts used in the integration programs.
- Projects included on the application should have been completed between March 1, 2017 and March 1, 2018.
- Active affiliated FCCLA chapter
- Three examples of integration of core academics into FACS coursework and FCCLA projects and activities
- Presentations and efforts to share techniques with other teachers and advisers
- Public relations efforts to increase awareness of integration of academics
- Three letters of recommendation:
  - School/building administrator
  - FCCLA Member
  - Nominee's FCCLA State Adviser

#### **Official Rules:**

- Nominees must be a current Family and Consumer Sciences educator and Family, Career and Community Leaders of America, Inc., adviser.
- Nominations must be typed.
- Winner will be selected based on the judge's evaluation of the given criteria. Judge's decisions are final.
- The nominee receiving the highest score will receive national recognition.
- One winner will be selected from eligible nominations.
- For award consideration, nominations must be postmarked by April 1, and sent to FCCLA National Headquarters.
- Winner will be recognized at the 2018 National Leadership Conference in Atlanta, Georgia.

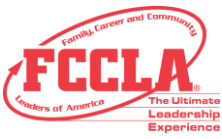
