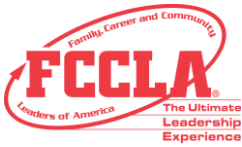

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The Adviser Academy is a five-track certificate program open to any adviser with fewer than five years of experience including recent university graduates. The Adviser Academy is comprised of four professional development tracks held during the **FCCLA National Leadership Conference** and one track completed at the state level within one year.

Graduates from Adviser Academy are recognized at the National Leadership Conference during the Recognition Session and will receive an FCCLA certificate of completion as well.

Track 1: Developing a Chapter Vision

Advisers will be introduced to the National Consultant Team, learn about FCCLA curriculum, tools and integrating FCCLA into the classroom.

Track 2: Engaging Dynamic Youth Leaders

Advisers will receive training on how to manage their chapters efficiently and learn how to set organized and attainable goals for the chapter and school year.

Track 3: Leading at School

Academy participants will be trained to be effective leaders and communicators in their schools. Participants will learn to involve key stakeholders, such as administrators and parents, and gain visibility for FCCLA by gaining professional development experience.

Track 4: Remaining Relevant as a Chapter

In the 4th track, the cohort will be encouraged to add to their program of work they built in Track 1 by integrating new national programs and STAR Events into their classrooms. This track will focus on building and maintaining a healthy chapter by working with local media and making connections with business and industry leaders in their communities.

Track 5: Participating at the State Level

Over the period of completing the Adviser Academy, participants will be required to build a strong relationship with their state adviser and participate in state meeting (e.g. conduct a workshop, evaluate STAR Events).
