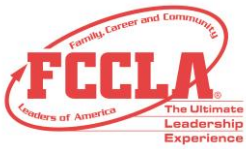


2018 FCCLA National Leadership Conference – Adviser Professional Development

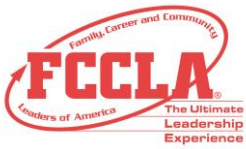
