ELIGIBILITY

- Students enrolled in a Career and Technical Center (grades 13-16) and postsecondary collegiate program.
- All STAR Events participants must be nationally affiliated members of FCCLA. Dues must be postmarked by March 1 and sent to national headquarters for participants to be eligible for national STAR Events competition. Local advisers are responsible for verification of membership and must bring a copy of the chapter affiliation highlighting each member's name to the event. Pilot Postsecondary chapter advisers are required to volunteer as a STAR Events evaluator or consultant at the National Leadership Conference.
