

# Financial Word Puzzles Learning Activity

## Purpose:

To engage young people in thinking about money, its meaning, and its use.

## Preparation:

1. Reproduce the Financial Word Puzzles, one sheet per participant.

## Instructions:

1. Give each participant a copy of the Financial Word Puzzles.
2. Review the instructions. Invite participants to work individually or in pairs.
3. Allow 3-5 minutes for participants to solve the puzzles.

## Processing:

1. Ask participants to share their puzzle solutions.
2. Ask participants to discuss what each solution phrase means, along with when and why it is used.
3. Explain that Financial Fitness helps young people think about money and how to use, save, and spend it wisely.
4. Ask participants to name other money-related sayings. Challenge them to create their own word puzzles for these phrases.

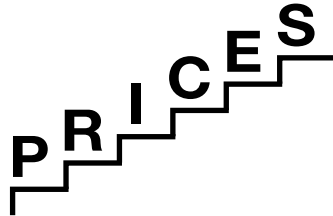

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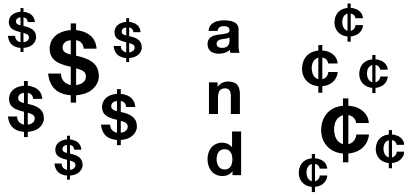

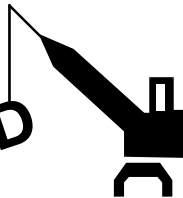


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
