<p><b>Activity 1</b> (Describe the independent activity to reinforce this lesson)</p>	<p>Students are to create a <i>display</i> using samples of their skills and following the Fashion Construction STAR Events guidelines on page 161 of the STAR Events Manual. Students will construct a garment or ensemble that dresses both the upper and lower body of a child or adult. Garment/ensemble must include at least eight fashion construction techniques. You will display your finished product along with appropriate accessories.</p>
