

Technical Specifications for Online STAR Events – Level II

(Originally included in emails sent to Level II qualifiers)

FCCLA will provide a laptop, with a hard-wired Internet connection, for you to present your digital project. You will be presenting your project from your website/wiki, and an additional projector/screen will not be available. The laptop (PC) will run Microsoft Windows 10 and will have Microsoft Office 2013, Internet Explorer, Firefox, and Chrome browsers. Standard plugins for QuickTime, Flash, Shockwave, and Adobe PDF will be installed. **If your project requires additional plug-ins for viewing, please modify your project for universal access as we will not be able to download software plug-ins or updates onsite.** You are encouraged to view your presentation on a computer OUTSIDE of your school's network – in a public library, friend's house, etc. – to see how it appears on different monitors, using a variety of browsers, etc.

Participants are HIGHLY encouraged to bring their digital projects on a USB drive, for backup purposes if needed. While we fully anticipate that the Internet connection will be working, we all know how technology can at times, fail. So, please be prepared with a backup.
