

# FCCLA Lesson Plan - Nurturing Children



Topic: Nurturing Children
Grade Level: 6-12
Timeframe: 30-60mins

Students will define nurture
Students will identify why nurturing children is important
Students will explore ways to nurture children

### **Materials Needed:**

Paper and writing utensil

Computer or device connected to internet



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**Activity 1:** Introduction

Ask - how do you know you are loved? In what ways do your parents or other caregivers show they love

Ask guided questions during discussions to ensure student understanding of main concepts

Activity 1 Timeframe: 5-10 mins Activity 1 Materials Needed: NA

#### **Activity 2:**

Using their text or a handout provided by the teacher have the students define what it means to nurture a child

Discuss answers/findings

**Activity 2 Timeframe:** 5-10mins

**Activity 2 Materials:** Classroom text/materials

#### **Activity 3:**

Have students research on the internet why nurturing children is important and have them report their findings to the class.

Discuss common findings.

Have students continue their online research by identifying ways to nurture children (can do this in small groups

with each group taking an area such as physical nurturing, emotional nurturing, intellectual nurturing, nurturing

infants, nurturing preschool age children, etc.)

Extension activities – assign written reflections and/or create a pamphlet for parents on nurturing children and distribute it. Report to the class.
