



Family, Career and Community Leaders of America 2018 National Technical Honor Society Scholarship Application

The National Technical Honor Society (NTHS) will award two (2) \$1,000 scholarships to current, qualified FCCLA members. Applicants must have applied to a degree-granting institution leading to an associate's or bachelor's degree in any field of study. Applicants will be evaluated based on the application information provided, and the recipients will be selected by a selection committee.

Please complete the following instructions to apply for the NTHS Scholarship.

Eligibility:

Open to **nationally** affiliated FCCLA members who:

- are current members of the National Technical Honor Society
- have affiliated nationally with FCCLA by March 1, 2018

Instructions:

1. **To Apply: Go to the [National Technical Honor Society Scholarship Online Application](#)**
2. Complete all sections of the application.
3. List information beginning with the most recent date first.
4. Use only the space provided. Do not send additional pages. Applicants will be judged solely on information contained on the online form and your letters of recommendation. Applications may not be revised after they are submitted. Applicants will receive a confirmation email and copy of the application once the online application is successfully submitted.
5. Documents needed for upload:
 - a. Your most recent official high school transcript including the first semester grades for the 2017-2018 school year. **Your official high school transcript must also include standardized college entrance exam scores (ACT and/or SAT).**
 - b. Two (2) letters of recommendation: one from their **local adviser**, and one from a **person knowledgeable of student's non-FCCLA activities**. (*Recommendations must be no more than one (1) page, and signed. Recommendation letters should be generic and addressed to the FCCLA Scholarship Committee. Applicants may use the same letters for each FCCLA scholarship they are applying for.*)
6. Application must be submitted by 5:00 PM EST **March 1, 2018**.

Procedure/Recognition:

Applications will be evaluated for style and expression as well as content. Conciseness of written remarks is recommended. This scholarship is a one-time cash award per recipient payable directly to the college or university in the fall of their freshman year. Funds come directly from National Technical Honor Society and must be applied toward tuition, room, and/or board. If recipient withdraws from college, unused funds must be returned. The winners will be notified by **April 2018**. Scholarship winners are invited to attend the 2018 FCCLA National Leadership Conference in Atlanta, GA to receive recognition for their award.
