Family, Career and Community Leaders of America is offering a limited number of scholarships to outstanding undergraduate Family and Consumer Sciences education majors interested in attending the National Leadership Conference. College students selected for this training event will receive a transcript verifying their participation and a regular registration reimbursement.

DEADLINE:

Nominations from teacher educators should be emailed or postmarked by **May 31, 2020**. Please check with students to secure their commitment before submitting applications.

We are seeking enthusiastic future Family and Consumer Sciences teachers with the following qualifications:

- Interested in learning what FCCLA has to offer students and advisers.
- Junior or senior majoring in Family and Consumer Sciences Education or related field of study; or postgraduate student in Family and Consumer Sciences teacher education or related field of study.
- Current or previous enrollment in a Family and Consumer Sciences education course.

The seminar will introduce participants to the organization and show future Family and Consumer Sciences teachers the many benefits of being an FCCLA chapter adviser. College students will learn how:

- Participation in FCCLA activities helps students develop leadership "skills for life."
- Chapter members use Family and Consumer Sciences skills to meet community needs.
- FCCLA chapters can make Family and Consumer Sciences programs more viable and enhance student recruitment.
- Advisers benefit from one-on-one contact with students outside of the school setting.
- To establish a chapter and develop co-curricular programs.

Persons who are selected will be expected to verify attendance at sessions throughout the conference that are chosen to best prepare students for future careers as FCS Educators and FCCLA advisers.

Participants should attempt to negotiate college credit with their universities for the experience. Teacher educators are encouraged to share possibilities for seeking credit with potential applicants.

<u>College students will be expected to register individually and pay all travel costs</u>. Following the meeting, the national organization will mail a check for up to \$190 for the registration fee to each participant successfully meeting the requirements and mailing in their participation form.

If scholarship recipient does not attend all required activities, reimbursement will not be awarded.

Participants will be selected based on:

- Applicant's motivations for attending
- Potential benefit to applicant

We hope you will encourage your undergraduate students to apply. The Newcomers college scholarship experience will include contact with FCCLA members, advisers, Alumni & Associates, and state and school administrators. Please share this opportunity with your students.

The FCCLA National Leadership Conference will be held in Washington, D.C. July 5-9, 2020.
