The Future Adviser Academy provides post-secondary students studying Family and Consumer Sciences with a series of lessons designed to enhance their skills and knowledge to prepare them to lead an FCCLA chapter. These lessons are available through the interactive Nearpod platform and offer a range of features such as multimedia presentations, interactive quizzes, and collaborative activities that enhance the learning experience. **Participants have until April 1 to complete all lessons in order to be considered for graduation.**
