

FUTURE ADVISER ACADEMY SESSIONS: EXPLORE

The Future Adviser Academy offers participants quarterly Zoom webinars that feature networking opportunities, keynote speakers, and engaging topics on how to start and lead an FCCLA Chapter that will be integrated into their FCS classrooms.
