It offers opportunities to create Nearpod lessons, develop FCCLA college-level courses, align standards with FCS education, and contribute to Competitive Events case studies. 4	<b>Serving as a Lead or Assistant Lead at the National Leadership Conference</b>	This essential session for FCCLA Master Advisers will focus on the responsibilities and best practices for serving as Lead or Assistant Lead Adviser for STAR Events at the National Leadership Conference (NLC). Participants will gain insights into the key roles and duties associated with these positions, including managing event logistics, coordinating with judges, and supporting student participants.
