FCCLA helps aspiring educators discover careers in education through resources and programs aligned to industry certifications and national standards. FCCLA also prioritizes a “Grow Your Own” program to prepare future educators to fill the teacher pipeline as well as build fulfilling careers in education and training.

Career Clusters

FCCLA is aligned to six career clusters, including Arts & Design, Education & Training, Financial Services, Hospitality & Tourism, Human Services and Public Services. Having a focus on a variety of career clusters allows members to acquire many skills to be college and career ready, employable, and expose students to work-based learning, business and industry networks, and industry-recognized certifications for an array of career opportunities.



How Does FCCLA Prepare Future Teachers?

FCCLA Members can gain skills that can help them become effective teachers, including:

Classroom Management:

Members have the opportunity to participate in planning and executing group projects in Competitive Events, which require them to manage groups of people effectively. These skills are essential for creating a positive and productive learning environment.

Curriculum Development:

FCCLA offers members opportunities to participate in events such as Teach or Train. Through these Competitive Events, members can learn how to create effective lesson plans that align with state and national standards and meet the needs of diverse learners.

Interpersonal Communication:

Members have the opportunity to develop interpersonal communication skills through interactions with peers, community members, partners, and government officials. These skills are beneficial in effective lesson plan delivery and establishing positive relationships with students, parents, and colleagues.

Leadership Development:

Members take on leadership roles, enabling them to develop essential skills for effective teaching, including communication, teamwork, problem-solving, and decision-making.
