Through this national program, FCCLA Members will test cutting-edge LifeSafer ISA technology — a real-world tool that prevents speeding, promotes smarter driving, and saves lives. Participants will gain hands-on experience, share their journey, and compete for an unforgettable prize.

What Is Intelligent Speed Assistance (ISA)?

Imagine having a co-pilot that helps you stay safe and confident behind the wheel. That is exactly what ISA does. Developed by LifeSafer, this breakthrough technology helps drivers stay within posted speed limits through real-time alerts and active speed management. Installed in minutes and compatible with most vehicles, ISA encourages smarter decisions every time you drive.

How It Works:

- Real-Time Speed Awareness: Alerts drivers when they exceed the speed limit.
- Active Speed Prevention: Uses GPS data to stop vehicles from accelerating beyond the limit.
- Parent Feedback: Sends post-trip reports to track performance and progress.
- Accountability Features: Includes tamper detection and safe learning settings.

Who Can Apply

To be eligible, applicants must:

- Be an active FCCLA Member ages 16–18.
- Hold a valid learner's permit or driver's license (under 18).
- Have access to a vehicle eligible for installation.
- Commit to six (6) months of participation.
- Receive parent or guardian consent.
- Attend virtual check-ins and share monthly updates.

Up to three students from each of the ten National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) regions will be selected to ensure national representation.

Timeline

- Application Deadline: Friday, November 14
- Selection Notifications: Friday, November 28
- Program Duration: Six months following device installation

Student and parent/guardian signatures are required.

3. Submit Your Application

Submit online by Friday, November 14.

4. Watch for Notification

Selected participants will be contacted by November 28 with next steps for installation and participation.
