# Intelligent Speed Assistance (ISA) Pilot Project

This Permission and Release Form ("Agreement") is entered into by the undersigned participant ("Participant") and their parent/guardian ("Guardian"), in connection with participation in the Intelligent Speed Assistance (ISA) Pilot Project, sponsored by Family, Career and Community Leaders of America (FCCLA), the National Road Safety Foundation (NRSF), the Governors Highway Safety Association (GHSA), and SCRAM Systems/LifeSafer ("Project Partners").

# 1. Voluntary Participation

## 3. No Effect on Insurance or Legal Standing

The Participant and Guardian understand that participation in this project will not affect the Participant or Guardian's automobile insurance rates or standing, nor will participation be reported to law enforcement or other agencies.

#### 4. Use of Data

The Participant and Guardian understand and agree that data collected during this project (driving behavior, survey responses, interviews, etc.) may be used by Project Partners for research, evaluation, and educational purposes only. Data will be analyzed and reported in aggregate form. Individual participants will not be identified by name in public reports or promotional materials.

### 5. Media Release

The Participant and Guardian grant FCCLA, NRSF, GHSA, and SCRAM Systems/LifeSafer the right to use photos, videos, audio recordings, and quotes from the Participant and Guardian in promotional, educational, and research-related materials, in print, online, and other formats, without compensation.
