

2026 FALL LEADERSHIP INSTITUTE FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs)

1. Who can attend the new Fall Leadership Institute?

The Fall Leadership Institute is open to all affiliated members and recommended for engaged leaders at the chapter, region, and state level.

2. Why is there limited spots?

We have a limited number of Disney sessions each day. These sessions are designed for small groups to give students a better learning experience. This year, we can accept 240 affiliated student members at each location.

Due to the limited spots, you will not be considered registered until payment is received. Please submit payment as soon as possible to guarantee your spot.

3. How do I ensure I am registered for the conference and my student's spot is guaranteed?

Once you submit your registration, it is considered submitted only – not registered. Your attendees are not considered registered until full payment is received. It is recommended that payment be made by credit card as soon as possible to ensure your spots are secured. You will be placed on a waiting list until the registration invoice is paid. Student spots will fill as payments are received. However, this means that registration is based on when the payment is received. Therefore, it is possible that at the time of payment, not all members submitted will have spots.

Due to advance purchases of park tickets and workshop sessions, if payment is not received by the payment deadline, you will not be considered registered and will not be able to attend.

4. How many students from one chapter can attend?

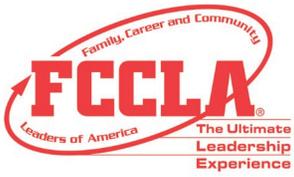
There is not a limit that each chapter can bring to FLI. We want as many members from across the country to experience this opportunity.

5. How many Disney workshops will each student have? When are they?

Each student will have a total of two Disney workshops. The student will be assigned a workshop each day based on their workshop combination selection. They must sign up for one of the eight workshop combination options available. The actual session times are not assigned until two weeks out.

6. How many official chaperones can attend the Disney workshops with the students?

Disney only allows one chaperone per small group session (15 students) to attend and assist. If you are interested in being a chaperone to one of the Disney sessions, please select this option in the registration process. Chaperones will be selected from those who signed up in the registration process.



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7. If I am not selected to be an official chaperone, what will I do while the students are in session?

All advisers/chaperones will have Disney park tickets for the same park as their student(s). You will drop off your student(s) at the designated meeting spot at the specified time. You are on your own until the scheduled pick-up time to pick up your students following their Disney session.

8. What if my school requires me to be with my student(s) at all times?

If you are not chosen to be an official chaperone for the Disney sessions, then you will not be able to be with your student(s) at all times. FCCLA recommends not attending the conference if your school has this rule. Registrations are non-refundable and we cannot guarantee you will be selected as a chaperone.

9. How do I register for the conference?

Login to the FCCLA Portal or go to <https://affiliation.registermychapter.com/fccla#>. Once you login select 'Meetings & Events' then '2026 Fall Leadership Institute-Location'. Register chapter advisers and members using the 'Register Students' and 'Register Advisers' buttons. Next, you will need to register any chaperones or parents attending with your students using the 'Register Guests' button. Once attendee information is entered, ensure to select 'Accept Disclaimers and Waivers' and then select 'Submit Registration' and 'Create Invoice' to complete the registration(s).

Please note: Once you submit a registration invoice, you will be responsible for paying that invoice unless the conference sells out before payment is made. You will not be considered officially registered until payment is received.

10. Is the hotel included in the registration? Are meals included?

No, the hotel is not included in the registration rate. Once registered, you will receive a registration confirmation email with the housing link to the FCCLA hotel block at the specified hotel.

A \$50 Disney gift card is included with the registration rate. The gift card can be used at all restaurants or shops within the park. The gift card is intended to assist with lunch each day in the park. However, you can use the gift card however you see fit.

In Orlando, a dinner is provided on Saturday, October 17 evening at the hotel. In Anaheim, snacks and beverages are provided on Thursday, November 12 evening at the hotel. All other meals are on your own.



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11. Why is the registration non-refundable?

FCCLA has to purchase the Disney workshop tickets, Disney Park tickets, Disney gift cards, and custom t-shirts in advance, therefore, we cannot provide refunds for the pre-purchased items. It is important to note that if you are unable to attend, you will be liable for the full cost once you have submitted the registration and paid by the deadline. You can however substitute to another person within your chapter.

12. Are we required to stay in the FCCLA hotel?

Yes, FCCLA contracted room rates and cost of meeting space are based on anticipated room pick-up. Registered attendees must stay within the official meeting hotel block when attending the conference.

Attendees not staying within the official conference hotel block will be assessed a \$125 fee per registration. This policy will not be implemented once the hotel block is sold out. Lack of availability of a preferred room type will not provide an exemption from this policy.

13. Will the Disney Park ticket be good at any park?

A reservation for a particular park each day will be assigned to the ticket. The park assignment will be based on where your student(s) Disney workshop is that day. Each ticket is a park hopper pass so you will be able to hop between parks on any given day. You must go first to the park that your reservation is assigned to. FCCLA will notify each student and adviser of their assigned tickets and parks each day.

14. What else is happening besides the Disney workshops and Parks?

FCCLA will have a dedicated kick-off session at the hotel the night before. Sessions will be led by FCCLA staff and the National Executive Council. These sessions will enhance the Disney methodology and help reinforce learned concepts to take back to the chapter and community.

A special session for advisers is held after the kick-off session to guide advisers through post-conference resources that will help students take their learning back to their chapters.

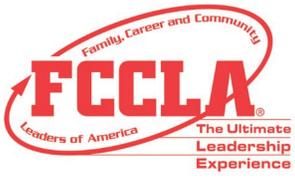
15. Are resources provided?

To help you make the most of your FLI experience, FCCLA (in partnership with Disney Imagination Campus) has created resources to guide students and advisers before and after the workshops. These materials will be sent out to registered attendees one month prior to the conference.

16. Why are we provided two custom t-shirts?

Included in the registration rate is two custom FCCLA branded t-shirts to be worn each day in the Disney parks. This helps the Disney session leaders to identify FCCLA attendees within the park and helps you to network with one another throughout the day. The color of each shirt will be sent out to registered attendees closer to the conference.
