



## Family, Career and Community Leaders of America, Inc. Summary of the April 2020 Board of Directors Meeting

Dear FCCLA Constituents,

The Family, Career and Community Leaders of America (FCCLA) National Board of Directors recently held a meeting in April 2020, and discussion was held on new and pending matters.

At this meeting, the Board of Directors approved to waive the six-month notification to change the date of the fall Board of Directors Meeting. The Board of Directors meeting was originally scheduled to meet September 10-12, 2020 at National Headquarters in Reston, Virginia. The Board of Directors fall meeting will now coincide with Capitol Leadership, these dates are to be determined.

Two new Board of Directors members were ratified. Theresa Golis was elected as the 2020 State Adviser Management Meeting and will join the Board as a State Adviser Representative of the Pacific Region. Linsey Shockley was elected by Lead FCS and will join the Board as a State Administrator Representative.

The FCCLA Bylaws address that if it is impossible to hold the national meeting, the National Officer Candidate election may be conducted electronically or by mail. The Board of Directors approved that if the National Leadership Conference is cancelled, National Officer Candidate elections will be held on an electronic system.

The Board of Directors approved to host the 2020 National Leadership Conference virtually with virtual Competitive Events. The virtual conference will take place July 7-9, 2020, and Competitive Events will take place in June. The registration price will be \$30 to attend and \$25 to compete (\$55 for competitors since they have to be registered for the conference in order to compete). The virtual conference content will be available for registered attendees through August. Visit the national website for more information and to register for the virtual conference.

Lastly, the Board of Directors approved the Executive Director to sign a single sale listing agreement with CBRE for the National Headquarters building.

The Board of Directors will meet again in May to continue the leadership work of the organization.
