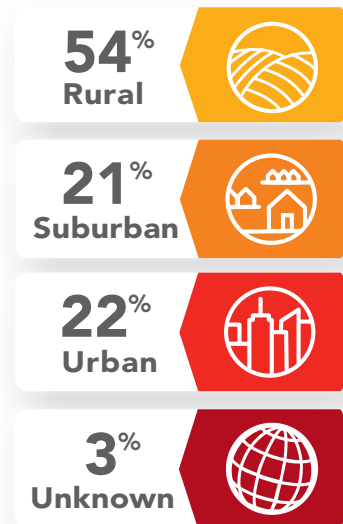

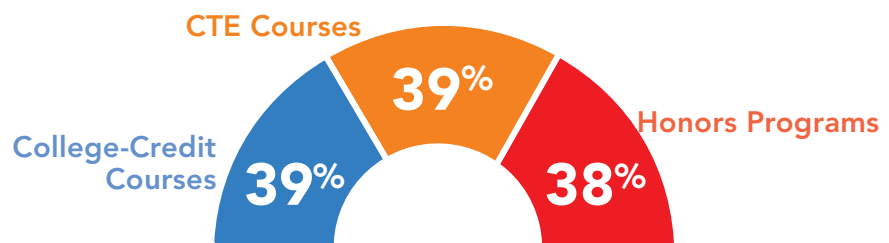

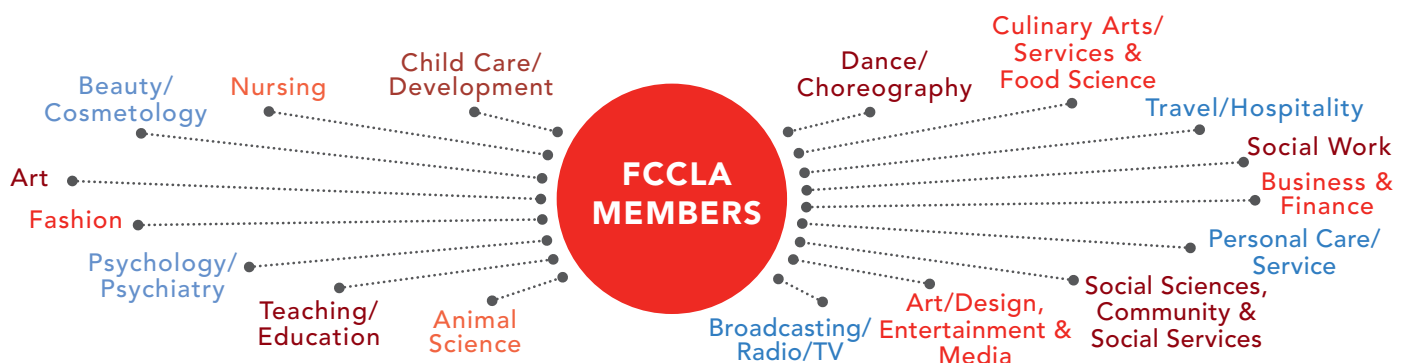

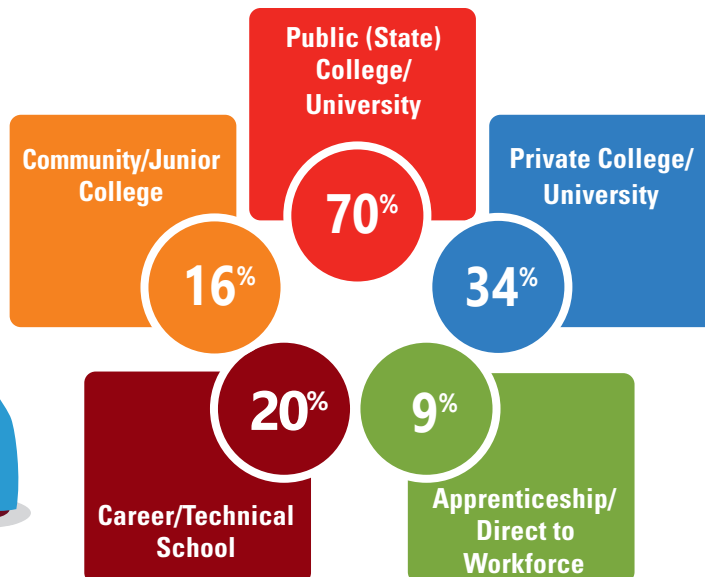
Top six skills students report gaining in their FCS classes:
