In partnership with FranklinCovey, FCCLA® is hosting a virtual Leadership Academy program that provides members with in-depth training on life-readiness skills that will benefit them as members and throughout their life. Through the Leader in Me platform, participants will work through self-paced materials, videos, and questions, that can be used as leader-led training or standalone learning opportunities.

The cost for each member to participate in FCCLA® Leadership Academy is \$60 per course. This includes access to the platform for the 10-week session, as well as weekly virtual discussion sessions facilitated by Leadership Training Team members. After completing the course, members will have the opportunity to earn 2 college credits through America College of Education by taking an exam (cost: \$65) and scoring an 85% or higher. The testing process is facilitated directly through FranklinCovey. Participants will receive a code to use when signing up for the test in addition to necessary testing information.

REGISTRATION

To participate, students must purchase the registration in the **FCCLA® Student Portal >E-Store Tab>FranklinCovey FCCLA® Leadership Academy**. <https://affiliation.registtermychapter.com/fccla#> Registration will be granted on a first come first serve basis to the first 200 participants. Log-in credentials and weekly session details will be emailed to participants.
