To participate in this FCCLA-recommended Community Service project:

1. Host a promotional booth or event at your school's next back-to-school night, sporting event, or other community-wide school event.
2. Distribute flyers at local grocery stores, community centers, SNAP and/or Welfare offices.
3. Post at least twice on your social media accounts to promote the Access from AT&T program.

The first 48 chapters to participate and submit a brief report of their promotional activities will receive a \$250 stipend. **The deadline for chapter reports is April 15, 2020.**
