Dear Constituents,

The Family, Career and Community Leaders of America (FCCLA) National Board of Directors recently held a meeting in January 2021. The Committees of the Board presented their reports and discussion was held on old and new business.

At this meeting, the Board of Directors approved to host the 2021 National Leadership Conference (NLC) as a hybrid meeting at the Omni Nashville. The conference will be held June 27-July 2, 2021. The maximum number of attendees that can attend in-person is under 2,000 and all attendees will have to stay within FCCLA's hotel block. All Competitive Events will take place virtually prior to NLC with the exception of Culinary Arts and Baking and Pastry that may need to be held in person for certifications. Registration will be \$150 per attendee for in-person and virtual. Competitive Events registration will be \$45 per participant. Registration and housing will open on April 1, 2021. Additional items that the Board of Directors approved during the meeting:

- The 2019-2020 Audit Report was approved as presented.
- The National Executive Council will begin to work with a student in Canada to develop a chapter pilot proposal that aligns with FCCLA's Policies and Procedures for evaluation in the 2021-2022 school year.

The Board of Directors will meet again in May to continue the work of the organization.
