Each opportunity listed contributes points toward the award, and this resource provides a clear and organized way to monitor your chapter's progress throughout the year.

As you work through the checklist, be sure to review the detailed descriptions provided for each opportunity. These descriptions offer concise guidance on what your chapter needs to do to fulfill the requirements and earn credit in the FCCLA Portal. Once an opportunity is completed, simply check it off to keep your chapter on track to achieving this prestigious recognition.

Stay engaged, stay organized, and work together as a chapter to meet the milestones necessary for the Ultimate Chapter Award. This checklist is your roadmap to success!

How to Earn the Award

To earn the FCCLA Ultimate Chapter Award, your chapter must complete a specific number of opportunities based on the highest grade level of students within your chapter. The number of opportunities required reflects the level of involvement and leadership expected:

- For chapters with members up to grade eight (8): You must complete at least 55 opportunities.
- For chapters with any members in grade nine (9) and above: You must complete at least 70 opportunities.

Types of Opportunities

To earn the FCCLA Ultimate Chapter Award, your chapter can accumulate credit through three types of opportunities, all tracked within the FCCLA Portal.

- **Automatic Tracking Opportunities:** Credit is awarded automatically when your chapter completes specific actions in the FCCLA Portal, such as affiliating members or registering for events.
- Application-Based Opportunities: Earn credit by submitting applications for awards, grants, or recognition programs directly through the FCCLA Portal.
- Reflection-Based Opportunities: Share your chapter's experiences and achievements through surveys or reflections in the FCCLA Portal to earn credit.
